## **CHAIRMAN'S REPORT:**

Chairman Casey reviewed the January 2022 mandates. 30hrs of mandatory in-service training must be completed every 3 years. 12hrs of scenario-based training (at least 6hrs of use of force to include de-escalation. At least 6hr of high-risk traffic stops).

Annual training on law updates, emergency medical response, crisis intervention and Officer wellness and mental health.

Every three years you must submit a verification form that confirm compliance with the certification requirements.

### **Highlights:**

- FY22 2<sup>nd</sup> QT ASSIST payment received; CPD \$100,000.00, Tri-River \$90,581.90 & 2<sup>nd</sup> half of audit \$7,500.00.
- HSG reimbursements received \$8,500.00.
- Supervision of FTO \$6,500.00 and Reid Basic & Advanced \$11,000.00 have been paid.

## **TRAINING:**

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D/C Davis mentioned March classes have been added to the training schedule. CRASH 1 has been opened to non-members due to the fact our members have not filled the class. CIT 06/06-6/10 and ARIDE 03/17-03/18/2022 has been added to the schedule and another ARIDE is scheduled in June 2022. We are working on scheduling a Use of Force TTT with Jeff Chudwin hopefully in May 2022.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

- Director Hertzmann reviewed the Training Schedule.
  - The master schedule has been updated with classes added into March 2022.
  - We have space available in Photography for Law Enforcement this Friday, December 17<sup>th</sup>.
  - WZ Interview and Interrogation and Advanced Interview and Interrogation are a couple of new classes just added. Both classes are covered by HSG and are reimbursable.
  - We have added six Mental Health Awareness an Intro to CIT Training courses to the schedule. This class covers a lot of mandates and is in the process of get recertified to meet the new SAFE-T Act mandates.
- Chairman Casey and Director Hertzmann reviewed the ILETSB Quarterly Board meeting held December 08-09, 2021.
  - 36 BLE Academies and 20 Correction Academies are scheduled for CY22 (January 2022-December 2022).
  - The ILETSB is low on key personnel and are lacking the office space and infrastructure for all the additional personnel that is needed.
  - Various House Bills are being watched; HB4240 and HB2784.
  - The ILETSB Executive Institute 2022 Women in Criminal Justice conference is scheduled for April 12-13<sup>th</sup>.
  - Looking to get the deadline extended for the review of officer complaints. They are hoping to expand the review panel and establish another screening panel related to officer complaints. Most of this is in HB3512 and stuck in the Senate.
  - ILETSB is reviewing the duties allowed by Part-Timer officers and may be updating how they can be used.
  - ASSIST program has distributed \$4.2 million of the \$6.2 million budgeted.
  - Don't forget to check the misconduct database with new hires. The public database portal should be up and running by January 1, 2022.
  - The ILETSB is hoping to finalize a model policy by March 2022 as it relates to the Mental Health Screening.
  - Changes are being made to the Camera grant. There will be a distinction between body cameras and in squad camera.
